Important Updates at Grace ...

Several guidelines and updates are coming in the next few weeks. Please read over the below information and mark your calendars.

- 1. There will be a **CONGREGATIONAL MEETING**, Sunday, May 23rd following worship. The purpose of this meeting is to present information regarding the painting of the sanctuary roof. The work bid is from Dependable Roofing at the cost of \$11,850. We did receive another estimate, but it was almost twice the cost. We need your attendance to vote on this project.
 - Please remember, if you would like your Building Fund envelop offerings to go to this project, please note "Roof Project" on the outside of your envelope.

2. Worship Covid guidelines and worship updates

- We will be continuing to practice safe Covid guidelines including
 - social distancing, providing hand sanitizer, fresh air flow, and wearing masks.

Having said this, we are adjusting mask wearing guidelines to the following:

- Masks are to be worn entering and leaving church as well as any time you are up and moving around the sanctuary.
- O When you are seated, you may remove your mask.
- We are recommending you consider wearing your mask the entire time if you have not been vaccinated.

- 3. As of May 2nd, we will return to serving communion in the pews. We will also be passing the plates to collect offering.
- 4. Our Outreach programs will also be making some changes.
 - o May 1st, First Saturday Free Community Meal will be Eat-in or Take out.
 - May 15th, "Boost your day with Breakfast" fundraiser will be Eat-in or Take out. We are planning to sell tickets in advance. This will help us plan for the amount of food needed.
 - o As of the first full week of May, <u>Grace's Closet</u> will be open three days a week, Monday, Wednesday, and Friday.
 - Laundry Love will continue not be available at this time due to the tight space at The Laundry Spot. We will revisit this each month as information updates.


CHURCH SERVICE VOLUNTEERS:

February 21, 2021

The meeting was called to order by President Margaret Stouffer at 8:30am.

Prayer was given by Pastor Ruzicka.

Welcome to new consistory members, Cathy Keefer and Chet Nye.

Work of the church: We have resumed in person services as well as the choir anthem following social distancing and use of masks plus hand sanitizer.

Agenda Additions: Additions to the Information Agenda include the Church Directory and Lenten Activities.

Consent Agenda: Motion by C. Shoemaker/S. Vanner to accept the consent agenda with one correction to the 1/26/21 minutes, to add to the cemetery fund explanation the upkeep of the cemetery, passed unanimously.

Information Agenda:

- 1. The committees and chairpersons paper handed out at last meeting was approved.
- 2. Activities Committee: They will be very busy in the coming months. March 6 First Saturday Meal; April 15, ham sandwich and soup sale; May 15, breakfast buffet fundraiser; July 9 and 10 Sidewalk Sales Days Yard Sale. Next meeting March 1.
- 3. Building and Grounds Report: Carpet replacement is completed and fire extinguisher inspection completed. The water leak around the range hood in the kitchen will be looked at as soon as possible. This was delayed due to the weather. The elevator contract with Kone was discussed. It was submitted for a 3 year term. Discussion included putting an alert/reminder to review the contract in Sept/Oct 2023. It was also suggested that a list/logbook be made to review contracts/agreements yearly.
- 4. Parsonage Payment Plan: The second payment was received as well as a picture of the signed contract. Larry will continue to urge Mike Evans and Brenda Clark to return to original signed contract as they have not done so. Communication with Nora Faust by Larry Stepler with what has been happening was not helpful.
- 5. Finance Committee: Motion by C. Shoemaker/C. Nye to accept the Kone Elevator contract passed unanimously. The electronic sign permission was denied by the city. There was discussion for use of the sign that was used on the float for previous Old Home Week parade. The hot water heater has been turned off during times the church is not in use. Jeff will be doing some "insurance shopping" to see if there is a more reasonable rate.
- 6. Homebound Outreach: A list of Shut Ins/Homebound members was distributed. Sydnae will coordinate making phone calls and reaching out to these members.

- /. Lenten Activities: Electronics have been placed in the sanctuary for use during the Lenten Bible Study.
- 8. Church Directory: Cathy distributed forms for completion to update the church directory.
- 9. Chet and Mildred are planning on coming in to clean the kitchen and bathrooms.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:38 am with the Lord's Prayer.

Roof repair – Dependable roofing will be contacted as to when they will start the repair. Discussion was held regarding financing the painting of the metal roof over the sanctuary, possibly a fundraising campaign using the building fund envelopes. Repair money for the bell tower roof and ceiling has already been set aside. Parking lot. Margaret and Jeff will speak with the owners asking about their liability insurance for any of their customer incidents that may occur in the parking lot.

Parsonage Payment Plan: Payment for the month of March has not been received. Larry has been in touch with Mike Evans. Larry will encourage electronic transfer of funds for future payments or to go to the website to make payments. As of March 21, 2021 we have not received a paper signed contract from Brenda Clark and Mike Evans, only a picture of their signatures. This picture does not have the Grace UCC signatures on it. It was decided that if we do not receive the signed contract by the end of March, they will be contacted again.

Finance Committee: KONE elevator contract invoice should be received in the next few days. Meetings will be set up with 3 different insurance companies to review the church insurance. It was decided to do these on March 22 and March 23, two on Monday and one on Tuesday with a vote taken on Tuesday as to which insurance company to go with.

Homebound Outreach: Sydnae have given lists of members to call. Progress is being made on the project.

Guest Pastors: Pastor Mark will contact Carrie and the conference to seek help in getting supply ministers for the month of July.

The meeting was adjourned with the Lord's Prayer.
