CONSISTORY MINUTES OF MEETING

February 20, 2022

ROLL CALL: Pastor Mark, Jeff Stouffer, Margaret Stouffer, Mark Stahl, Carolyn Shoemaker, Chet Nye, Cathy Keefer, Lorna Thomas, and Deb Homer. Absent in person but participated via phone: Lu & Steve Miller The meeting was called to order at 8:30 am by Outgoing President, Margaret Stouffer.

DEVOTIONS: Pastor Mark read Psalm Chapter 37: 3 – 11.

WORK OF THE CHURCH: Lorna Thomas and Deb Homer were welcomed as new members. <u>Election of Officers</u> – Carolyn Shoemaker nominated Jeff Stouffer as President, Mark Stahl as Vice President, Cathy Keefer as Secretary and passed unanimously. Margaret has redone the handbook and they are not completely finished. She will be distribute when done.

CONSENT AGENDA: Passed by a Jeff Stouffer/Chet Nye motion and passed unanimously. It was noted under Building and Grounds that the \$1600.00 for the boiler repair and service agreement was paid by donations from several members.

INFORMATION AGENDA:

<u>Pastor Mark</u>: He was attending an installation of the Settled Minister at Zion UCC today at 2. Larry noted that the Pension Board has not responded back to him. Pastor Mark will send in 3 reservations for the seminar on May 21st at St. John's UCC in Chambersburg.

The Service of Installation for Pastor Mark is scheduled for April 24th at 3 pm and a meal will be served after the service. Carolyn and Deb will spearhead the meal.

<u>Activities and Fundraising Committee</u> – Consider having the yard sale and chicken Bar-B-Que.

<u>Building and Grounds & Parking lot agreement</u> — a fire extinguisher needs updated and Jeff Stouffer will donate that. Regarding the parking lot, Joel Henry, our insurance agent, sent us forms (to hold Grace UCC harmless if an accident occurs on parking lot) to forward to Melissa and Chris to sign. They in turn passed the forms on to their attorney for review. We are looking for some financial assistance from them for the upkeep of the parking lot since they use it.

<u>Finance Committee</u> – need to get more members involved in volunteerism. It was thrown out for a brief discussion to taxi any members unable to drive themselves to service.

<u>Called to Care</u>: Pastor Mark said calls are being made and are confidential in nature.

ACTION AGENDA:

Jan Shaffer requested to use the Social Hall on August 12th for a class reunion function and there will not be a fee associated with this use. Additionally, Ed & Gladys Doyle want to do some landscaping in the front of the church with adding shrubs. They will donate the shrubs and do the planting. A Time of Fellowship will be held after service on the Second Sunday of the month. Nancy Myers presented the idea of Pantry Pouches to be assembled by the congregation and donated to the two Food Banks in town. The action agenda passed unanimously after a motion by Margaret/Carolyn.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:30 am with the Lord's Prayer. Next meeting will be March 20, 2022 at 8:30 am.

WORK OF THE CHURCH: Decision was made to remove from the bulletins the Covid safety measures but to keep the live streaming section.

AGENDA ADDITIONS & SUBTRACTIONS: Under Building & Grounds for February's Meeting – corrected the fire extinguisher needs to be updated next year and Jeff Stouffer will donate that.

CONSENT AGENDA: Motion made by Lorna/Carolyn to approve and was passed unanimously.

INFORMATION AGENDA:

<u>Pastor Mark</u>: Suggested distributing invitations to the Installation Service to those in attendance at services to share with others. Of note, invitations were also being sent to members not attending.

<u>Building & Grounds</u>: The Shoppe & Consignment Shop have presented a signed agreement to hold GUCC harmless regarding any injuries that may occur in the parking lot & have agreed to pay \$1200.00 per year.

Mark suggested the men's bathroom floor needs attention and he indicated that vinyl flooring would run around \$975.00. A motion was made by Carolyn/Chet and was approved unanimously to give Mark the okay to do. Jeff reported that solar energy may not be the way to go to decrease the church's electric bill as the cost would be currently too high (\$32,000.00 to \$60,000.00). This has been tabled for the time being.

Larry stressed that we would not want to pull this amount from the Masser fund. Additionally, Jeff will be looking into the possibility of changing the lights to LED.

ACTION AGENDA: To cut down on paper, consider placing the Hymn number in the bulletin instead of printing the entire hymn which would result in using the hymnals. Larry mentioned placing the pew that had been removed in the front of the sanctuary back to its original home and move the hymnal rack from the men's bathroom as well. This will be done when "strong" help can be secured. Lorna suggested that GUCC not lend out the medical equipment due to liability issues and a motion by Carolyn/Cathy to donate the equipment to the Lutheran Church and this passed unanimously.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:35 am with the Lord's Prayer.

SPECIAL CONSISTORY MEETINGS REGARDING LIABILTY INSURANCE HELD ON 3/27/2022

IN ATTENDANCE: Jeff Stouffer, Pastor Mark, Carolyn Shoemaker, Chet Nye, Mark Stahl, Lorna Thomas, Cathy Keefer

The cost of the church's liability coverage increased almost 18% showing the premium to be \$8702.00 from Bitner-Henry Insurance with a due date of April 1, 2022. Last year's annual policy was \$7396.00.

Discussion pursued regarding this increase since we had budgeted \$8500.00. After a motion by Lorna/Carolyn with a unanimous vote, the decision was made to request Bell Insurance to obtain a quote. Jeff will contact Carrie Heckman at Bell for a figure and Consistory will meet then to vote on possibly changing.

Additionally, Mark shared several vinyl tile samples. This will be to replace the existing floor in the men's bathroom and one was chosen by the members.

SPECIAL CONSISTORY MEETINGS REGARDING LIABILTY INSURANCE HELD ON 3/29/22

IN ATTENDANCE: Jeff Stouffer, Mark Stahl, Carolyn Shoemaker, Lorna Thomas, Larry Stepler

Consistory members met with Carrie Heckman from Bell/Brethren Insurance. Last year's annual policy from Bitner-Henry Insurance was \$7396. This year, our insurance rate increased <u>almost 18%</u> with no loss runs to \$8,702. Carrie presented a new insurance premium to be \$6,915, which also includes Workers Comp. as well as a \$1,000,000 liability umbrella, again, totaling \$6,915. This means a savings our Grace UCC of almost \$1,800. So, we voted this evening to switch to Bell Insurance for the betterment of our Church.
