CONSISTORY MINUTES OF MEETING

May 15, 2022

ROLL CALL: Jeff Stouffer, Pastor Mark, Mark Stahl, Lorna Thomas, Deb Homer, Chet

Nye, Carolyn Shoemaker, Larry Stepler ABSENT: Cathy Keefer

DEVOTIONS: Pastor Mark read Psalm 46.

WORK OF THE CHURCH: Covid is starting to increase. No changes made.

AGENDA ADDITIONS/SUBTRACTIONS: Education – no scholarship applications.

CONSENT AGENDA: Motion made by Carolyn Shoemaker/Mark Stahl to approve and passed unanimously.

INFORMATION AGENDA:

<u>Pastor Mark</u>: On May 21st, he will be attending a workshop on Church Growth along with Marg Stouffer, Carolyn Shoemaker, & Deb Homer. There were no updates or concerns regarding Called to Care Committee.

<u>Fundraising and Activities</u>: The upcoming scheduled Fundraising Events are as follows: Breakfast on May 21st; Yard Sale on July 8th; Chicken BBQ on July 8th.

<u>Building & Grounds</u>: *Kitchen Sewer Drainage Pipes* - Mark Stahl reviewed a bid from East Coast Trenchless to repair the drainage problem. He also researched multiple estimates for the project and a motion was made by Carolyn S./Chet N. to override these estimates. A motion was made by Deb H./Carolyn S. to accept the bid by East Coast Trenchless at a cost of \$7432.00 and this passed unanimously. The ladies' restroom will be closed effective 5/15/22 until completion. Mark S. will update the congregation of the drain repair to see if funds can be generated. *Repair of round window facing the parking lot* – Mark S. got an estimate of \$300.00 for rental of a lift and \$500.00 to repair and paint the window. A motion was made by Jeff S./Carolyn S. to proceed with the window repair and was approved and passed unanimously. *Cemetery mowing/weeding* is being done by church members.

<u>Finance Committee</u>: The church will be experiencing significant billing increases from Columbia Gas, West Penn, Comcast, Atlantic Securities of approximately 10% to 25+%. Continued ideas of ways to save the church money is welcome. Larry S. gave an overview of Grace's finances.

ACTION AGENDA: No action was taken regarding the moving of the pew/benches back to their original home or the streaming equipment. Carolyn S. will follow up regarding reserving the Nelson Pavilion at the King Playground for the 2nd Sunday of September for future years.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:40 with the Lord's Prayer. Next meeting will be June 19th at 8:30 am.

<u>Fundraising & Activities</u>: Upcoming Yard Sale and Chicken BBQ is scheduled for July 8th with tickets being sold and "treasures" being dropped off.

<u>Building & grounds:</u> Kitchen/Sewer/Bathroom issue is fixed and the Women's bathroom is now open after Chet and Mildred cleaned it. Mark is working on getting estimates to have the round window repaired/painted and one estimate is \$750.00. The cemetery mowing is being kept up by a great team of volunteers and several remarks from the public were shared with how nice it looks.

<u>Finance Committee</u>: Will consider having Larry evaluate the church's funds.

ACTION AGENDA: A motion by Carolyn/Chet to keep the pew in the social hall and return the front pony wall back to the front of the sanctuary was passed unanimously. Regarding the growth of the church, Pastor Mark recommends "word of mouth" and possibly doing individual interviews as to "why I love Grace UCC church" and share on Facebook. Additionally, a brief discussion was held regarding the safety of our church family and measures to take to develop a security plan to assure continued safety measures. This will be discussed more at a later date once we discuss a plan with our insurance agent. To be discussed later is the removal of the water fountains.


The meeting was adjourned at 9:35 am with the Lord's Prayer.


