I hope you enjoy this prayer.


Remember "blessed are you."

CONSISTORY MEETING MINUTES

August 21, 2022

ROLL CALL: Pastor Mark, Jeff Stouffer, Deb Homer, Larry Stepler, Carolyn Shoemaker, Cathy Keefer Chet Nye. Ron Shaffer and Nancy Myers were invited to attend.

DEVOTIONS AND PRAYERS: None as time restraint on guest speaker.

CONSENT AGENDA: These were reviewed by each member on their own time and no motions to pass were not done due to length of security discussion by Curt Wood.

PRESENTATION BY CURT WOOD REGARDING SECURITY IN THE CHURCH

Curt Wood is a member of The Otterbein Church in Waynesboro and he is on the security team there. He spent 29 ½ years as a Hagerstown Police Officer and was kind enough to visit Grace UCC and suggest measures to protect our church family, i.e., be aware with regards to new attendees and anything out of the norm. An enlightening discussion with Curt pursued and numerous suggestions were made with the consideration of a push button either in the pulpit or back at the boards, tighter security measures of the exterior doors, and removal of the front door key from the hook to a hidden location. Further discussion of the development of a safety team will be made at a later date.

INFORMATION AGENDA:

<u>Pastor Mark</u>: He stated two new members, Kate Kennedy and Mary Lou Bryan, are being taken in on August 28th with a reception following. The picnic is scheduled for September 11th with worship prior to. He also mentioned that Christmas falls on a Sunday this year and we may want to consider not having a service since we'll have a beautiful Christmas Eve Service.

<u>Fundraising & Activities</u>: Ham sandwich and soup sale is September 15th and the First Saturday Free Community Meal is on October 1.

<u>Building & Grounds</u>: New paint & flooring in men's bathroom and the round parking lot window will be repaired.

<u>Finance Committee</u>: Larry presented a detailed review of the church's assets and expenses. The money in the IMA account was hit due the stock market but is rebounding but is still down about \$29,000.00 for this year. It was noted that utilities costs exceeded 2021 by 29.8%. Savings were made to due insurance change and cemetery care.

ACTION AGENDA: We are to think of new members to come on consistory for 2023 as the annual meeting will be held on January 15, 2023.

The meeting was adjourned and the next meeting is September 18, 2022.
