This year Ash Wednesday and Valentine's Day are on the same day. This happened a few years ago. It is always a creative venture to combine two different things and see what comes out of it. Ash Wednesday we remember that we are dust and to dust we shall return. On Valentine's Day, we celebrate that love is strong and eternal. So, this got me thinking of devotional poetry—poetry in which we express our love back to God...because of God's foundational love for us. One great example of this comes from St. Ignatius of Loyola, he was a Spanish saint who lived in the 1500s and founded the Jesuit order. This particular prayer was translated by Gerard Manley Hopkins (and then adapted by me).

I love thee, God, I love thee—
Not out of hope for heaven for me
Nor fearing not to love and be in the everlasting burning.
You, my Jesus, toward me did reach Your arms out dying,
For my sake suffered nails and lance,
Mocked and marred countenance,
sorrows passing number,
Sweat and care and cumber,
Yes and even death, and this for me,

And You could see me sinning:

Then I, why should not I love thee, Jesus...so much in love with me?


Not for heaven's sake, not to be out of hell by loving thee; Not for any gains I see;





#### **CONSISTORY MINUTES FOR OCTOBER 15, 2023**

Meeting was called to order at 8:30 a.m. by Co-President Carolyn Shoemaker.

ROLL CALL: Carolyn Shoemaker, Pastor Mark, Lorna Thomas, Tim Bryan, Ron Shafer Chet Nye, Larry Stepler, Treasurer, guests Mark Stahl.

DEVOTIONS: Pastor Mark read Psalm 77.

CONSENT AGENDA: The minutes for September Consistory and the Treasurer's report was approved unanimously on a Ron/ Carolyn motion.

#### **INFORMATION AGENDA UPDATES:**

Activities/Fundraising – Chet reported that November 4<sup>th</sup> will be the Thanksgiving turkey dinner. Apple dumplings will be made on Nov. 17 with pick-up from 3-6pm. Any extra apple dumplings will be sold during the Christmas parade on Sat., Nov. 18<sup>th</sup>.

Carolyn reported that Laundry Love assisted 6 people on October 10<sup>th</sup>.

<u>BUILDIING</u> and <u>GROUNDS</u>: Mark reported that new lights were installed inside the front entrance to the church and the Sanctuary. Tim installed wo new toilets in the Ladies bathroom and the stall doors now open outward. In the hallway bathroom the toilet was rebuilt.

Still have significant increases in water bill for no apparent reason. The borough was requested to come over and check the meter and wiring to meter. Barry is also going to the Borough office to speak with them.

The water softener sample taken to Negley's to be tested shows 2 grains hardness should be 0 grains. Tim will continue to follow up softener.

<u>FINANCE</u>: Larry thanked the Fundraising committee for their work with various. We are approximately \$4000 over the \$10,000 we budgeted to bring in.

Larry will be sending a letter to Mike Evans thanking him and then closing the parsonage account as it is paid in full.

Larry is still dealing with the ERTC the IRS has a backlog. Larry received paperwork and the monies will be paid directly from the IRS.

Sunday, December 24<sup>th</sup>, the choir will present their Christmas Cantata during the morning service. Pastor Mark will present a sermon during the Candlelight service.

#### ADDITIONAL TOPICS for DISCUSSION:

The annual organ report from Lewis & Hitchcock was reviewed with no decision made at this time.

Election day is November 7<sup>th</sup>, Carolyn is checking to see if Jeff can open and close the church that day. Several consistory members plan to put the booths together on Saturday, November 4<sup>th</sup> after First Saturday meal.

Elaine and Cathy are in the process of getting forms prepared for sales tax refunds from previous years' electric and gas bills.

DEVOTIONS: Deb said a quick prayer.

CONSENT AGENDA: The minutes from September Consistory meeting were approved on a Cathy/Carolyn motion. Treasurer's report was approved unanimously on a Deb / Lorna motion.

#### INFORMATION AGENDA UPDATES:

<u>Activities/Fundraising</u> – Lorna reported on Frist Saturday meal, served 78 meals and had \$400.00 in donations. December, January and February meals are planned.

Carolyn reported that for Laundry Love, herself, Syd and Bobbie were there to volunteer. It was decided to only do evenings from now on, as not enough people come out in the mornings.

#### **Building and Grounds** –

- 1. Tim and Barry installed more LED bulbs in offices, bathrooms, etc.
- 2. Mark reported that painting of the ladies rest room is on the schedule.
- 3. Carolyn brought up that the social hall floor needs stripped and waxed, Mark is checking into this.

#### Worship and Spiritual Life -

1. We had a discussion on Lay Sundays, formed a committee to look into this.

#### Additional Topics for Discussion:

- 1. Piano and Organ will be tuned before Dec 9.
- 2. Atlantic Security fixed panel by social hall.
- 3. Holiday Concert is on December 9, in the sanctuary. Discussion on what to pay participants, checking with Marg on that.
- 4. The Christmas House Tour is December 10, our church is on it; so we need people to help.
- 5. Larry brought some interesting figures to us: income from fund raising in 2022 up to October was \$7,300 in 2023 it is \$16,000; member's donation's in 2022 up to October were \$51,200 in 2023 it is \$61,800.

- 6. Our contract with KONE Elevator is up in January. Jeff has some different prices from other contractors. We are leaving it up to the Building and Grounds Committee to look into this.
- 7. Trees at the church cemetery need trimmed.
- 8. Jeff is having surgery at the end of January, so we need other people to help with the sweeping of the church.
- 9. There is wax on the carpet in sanctuary under where the candelabras sit for Christmas Eve Service. We need to get something to set them on.
- Grace's Closet is going to cancel trash collection and Jeff is going to take their trash to the dump. Grace's Closet will donate \$300 annually to the church.
