

The Crown and Open Bible


Anchor and Descending Dove

Holy Spirit.


The Alpha and Omega, The Ivy and the Harp



The **Alpha and Omega** are the first and last letters of the Greek Alphabet. They recall these words from (Revelation 21:6, "I am the Alpha and the Omega, the beginning and the end."

The **Harp** symbolizes all music that glorifies Almighty God and the **Ivy** symbolizes life. When used in this combined way, they refer to the Total Life in God, both in the flesh and in the spirit.
